# The Conceptualization of Robust Equity

- Thriving in all life domains
  - social
  - emotional
  - cognitive
  - physical
  - economic
  - spiritual
  - environmental
- Individually and as part of a group
- In the moment and over one's life
- Thriving builds upon objective and subjective well-being but also includes the experience of and capacity to have and be:
  - Agentic- acting on and shaping one's environment
  - Grounded-- belonging and having a sense of history, place, and future

# Robust Equity Requires

- Eliminating and combating institutionalized oppression and privilege and their manifestation in mindsets, structures, protocols, processes, tools, experiences, and incentive structures
- Transforming structures and institutions and building new settings and structures when necessary
- Building and supporting inclusive structures, settings, and processes that build and support the experience of thriving and capacities of individuals and groups to thrive and support others in thriving
- Building upon:
  - The science of learning and development and implementation science
  - The lived experiences and knowledge of people who experience and address oppression
- Providing supportive conditions and developing individual and collective competencies and assets

A young person's success in any life arena is linked to learning, equity, & their capacity to thrive



# Robust Equity Entails

- Expanding our conceptualization and operationalization of the components of each domain
- Understanding and leveraging the interconnections between and across domains
   --both in the moment and over time
- The cognitive domain and deeper learning provide examples
  - Deeper learning <-> Shallow learning
  - Transformative learning <-> Adaptive learning
  - Holistic Learning <-> Narrow learning
    - Nurturing the interconnected mind, body, and spirit and does so in a manner that is humanizing
    - Developing analytic, synthetic and creative skills
    - Leveraging and developing awe, wonder, and passion
    - Building connections and embracing diversity while understanding differences and uniqueness
    - Developing a sense of responsibility and critical consciousness along with the resources to act on this knowledge
